POVERTY AND MIGRATION

Mission: Develop sustainable communities and protect the human rights of migrants

Strategic Actions:

- Support literacy and vocational programs
 - Educate and disseminate information on applicable legislative and “English as a Second Language” (“ESL”) classes
 - Educate citizens about immigration
 - Support and/or create microfinancing programs for women
 - Teach business courses to women immigrants
 - Through networking, share ideas regarding the elimination of poverty and the support of migrants
 - Study, and get involved with, existing organizations that support immigrants
 - Contact potential group partners to provide support to local immigrants
 - Contact elected leaders to support land reform in other countries
 - Schedule community seminars to raise awareness about concerns of immigrants
 - Seek ideas to stop trafficking from groups already active in these issues
 - Mobilize women by training women leaders in politics and legislation
 - Mentor a refugee or a refugee family
 - Form bilingual community center to bring cultures together
 - Contact elected officials to eliminate detention centers for immigrant children
 - Develop a network of “senior servants” (retired professionals) who are willing to perform volunteer services locally and abroad
 - Support women in Darfur through donations, networking and/or support of international aid groups
