Rita Marie Johnson developed a national model of peace in Costa Rica. She is the founding director of the Rasur Foundation, the main project of which is the Academy for Peace of Costa Rica (previously known as the “Peace Army”).

The mission of this academy is to ensure that the skills of “feeling peace” and “speaking peace” will be passed from generation to generation. These skills are transmitted through the school system using the practice of “BePeace,” an approach based on Johnson’s discovery of the synergy between the social and learning methodologies, HeartMath® and Nonviolent Communication.

As an international peacemaker, Johnson has presented workshops in the US, Europe and Central America. In November 2006, she completed a speaking tour in Japan on Costa Rica as a model of peace.
